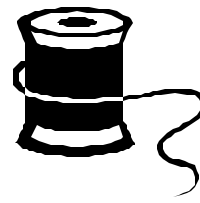

## 36<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL BLACK HILLS QUILT SHOW

June 11, 12 and 13 at the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center, Rapid City

9 to 5 Friday and Saturday, 10 to 4 Sunday

Admission: Free to guild members (with membership card)

\$5 per day for adults or \$10 for a 3-day pass

**DEADLINES:** All entry forms must be received by Tuesday, May 4. Entry forms are available on the website, in local quilt shops and from Carol Doyle. They must be returned to Carol in person or by mail. **Quilts will be turned in for the show on Wednesday, June 9 at the Civic Center.**

**JUDGED & NON-JUDGED CATEGORIES:** You may enter your quilts in either the Judged or the Non-Judged category. Entry fee for the Judged category is \$10 per item for BHQG members and \$15 per item for all others. Payment must be received with registration form. **There is no entry fee for non-judged items.** Our judge this year is Klaudeen Hansen, an NQA-certified judge from Wisconsin. Klaudeen judges at many national shows, including Paducah. Ribbons for winning quilts in the Judged category will be on display when the show opens. Viewers will choose the winners in the Non-Judged category and for Best of Show during show hours. All Judged and non-judged quilts are eligible for the BEST OF SHOW vote. Winners will be announced at the banquet on Saturday and ribbons will be on the winning quilts on Sunday.

**AWARDS BANQUET:** Saturday, June 12, at 5 pm in the Alpine Room. **Entertainment:** Trunk shows by Joan Davis of the Quilt Corral, Joan Kettlewell of the Quilt Connection and Pearl Louise Krush of the Thimble Cottage. Cash bar. Seating is limited. **Menu:** spinach salad, champagne chicken, mashed potatoes, vegetable medley, rolls and triple chocolate cake. The 2011 Raffle Quilt will be unveiled. This quilt was made by guild members and quilted by Marie Brewer of Pine Needle Quilting. Tickets for the banquet are \$25 and are available now at local shops or contact Rhonda Jenner.

**SPECIAL EXHIBITS:** The BHQG Fabric Challenge quilts, BHQG Round Robin quilts, and a challenge group from the Sun Prairie Quilters Guild of Wisconsin.

**TRUNK SHOWS AND DEMOS:** Come to the room along the west wall to enjoy a trunk show by our last year's Best of Show winner, Marilyn Hoelsher. Demo's will be offered during the show by members and vendors (see list on page 3). Contacts: Joyce Ketterling, Darlene Huettl, Dixie Knappen-Mitzel, and Bev Peterson

**VENDORS:** Vendors from local shops and as far away as Texas, Arizona and California will be at the show offering a variety of quilting supplies and quilting-related products. Vendor booths will be open during show hours. Contact: Marie Brewer

**SILENT AUCTION:** Looking for SQOs! (That's the jargon for Small Quilted Objects—and they don't even have to be quilted!) If you have a project that you would be willing to donate to the Hospice of the Hills, we would love to have it. We have had lots of wall hangings, runners, and table toppers, but also jewelry, doll house furnishings, dolls, oven mitts, etc. The emphasis is on the "small"—it needs to be smaller than a baby quilt because of our display space. Please get your donations to Shari West Twitero by NO LATER THAN Tuesday, June 8 (that's the Tuesday before the show). The auction starts at Rapid City Regional Hospital in the Main Lobby on Wednesday, June 9 and runs through the show. (If you don't see Shari, ask someone to get it to her or call 343-9317 to work out a pick up.) Thanks!

**UFO's** The show is a great reason to drag out your unfinished projects and get them done! Don't forget to submit your UFO forms (available on the BHQG website) to Rosa Lea Grav. Small prizes and a traveling trophy are at stake!

**SALE OF QUILTS:** Project Warmth. Approximately 350 quilts are made and given away by the Guild each year. The quilts offered for sale at the Quilt Show help pay for supplies (and are very good deals for you!) If you would like to make a donation of a quilt or quilting related item, Contact: Susan Corbin.

**SALE OF QUILTS AND QUILTED ARTICLES:** Guild Members. There will again be a booth to place quilted items for sale. No advanced registration is required. Bring your quilts for sale to the Civic Center on Wed., June 9, when you bring your quilts for the show. Fill out a "Quilt For Sale" form and set your sale price. The BHQG retains 10% of the proceeds. Check your closets and shelves and place a few items for sale so you can make room for new projects. You might make a bit of extra cash to buy new fabric! **RAFFLE QUILT DRAWING:** The winner of the guild's 2010 quilt will be drawn Sunday afternoon. This queen-sized quilt was pieced by guild members and longarm quilted by Lauri Tigner. Tickets will be on sale at the show until the drawing.

**GOODIE BASKET RAFFLE:** Tickets will be sold during the show, winning ticket will be drawn on Sunday. The basket features fat quarters of batiks and hand-dyes, new quilting notions and other wonderful items. To donate items for the basket, contact Darlene Geboe.


