### *Meet the Teachers*

**Colleen Blackwood** comes to us from Pendleton, Oregon. With her Laughing Lizzies patterns, she likes to take traditional blocks, rearrange them, and then add her own touch to develop new patterns. Friday's **Woven Wire** takes a simple Rail Fence combo to a great new plaid look. Her new **Pathway to the Stars** is the Saturday class. If, however, you prefer one of her other patterns, she says that's possible too!

Scraps, scraps, scraps—they are always there and what to do with them? Known for her beautiful long-arm work, **Kathy Lorch** is also a dedicated scrap collector/user. She will show you all the cool things that she has learned since she became addicted to the Quiltville techniques of Bonnie Hunter. You'll find uses for your Easy Angle and strip rulers that you never thought of. The class is **My Blue Heaven!** but nothings says *your* heaven has to be blue! Need a cute, quick gift? We're "importing" **Lois Massa** from Custer with just the idea for you. At her trunk show for the guild, we

enjoyed seeing her **Open Windows**. You can use novelty fabric for a neat seasonal gift or pick something more universal for a year-round decoration.

If you went to the Black Hills Stock Show quilt show, you might have seen **Joyce McClanahan's** autumn leaf quilt and wondered—how did she do that? It is all based on Judy B. Dales' technique for **Curved Seam Piecing**. Joyce developed a class for her former guild and now she's willing to share with us. She has three projects to choose from. Our illustration shows four of the simplest blocks as they appear in a wall hanging. This is a technique class rather than a project class. Judy B. Dales' book *Curves in Motion* is recommended, but not required.

Do you sometimes feel that your wall hangings just need something more? **Glenda Neal** has just what the quilt doctor ordered—it's **Dimensional Appliqué** (and then some if you do it all!). Glenda will show you a number of techniques to add dimension to any of your projects.

Want to advance to a new level in appliqué? Then choose one of **Susan Taylor Propst's** classes. She's recently returned from England to the US, has a new book out, and is raring to go. In her Friday class **Unit Appliqué** class you will learn techniques for constructing the complex units featured in her book *Beautiful Blooms*. On Saturday you can

color your fabric and begin work on the center block of the lovely **Colored Lily Appliqué** pattern. Please be aware that some experience with appliqué is required for either of these classes.
